# DID YOU KNOW?

if you received a silk scarf at Christmas, it is made from cocoons of the silk moth. Each moth can lay about 400 eggs, which grow into caterpillars. The caterpillars gorge on mulberry leaves and then spin a cocoon made of fine silk, which can be up to half a mile in length. About 250 cocoons are needed to spin and weave into a scarf.
