# HOSE FETE HOSE FETE

Now in its ninth year Hose Fete will take place on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> July between 12 noon and 4pm. The festivities will span The Green, Church and School Grounds and will encompass traditional fete favourites, truly offering something for everyone!

The official opening of the fete this year will be preceded by the ringing of the church bells and followed by a dancing display from the Children at Hose School on the village Green. The Green will then play host to representatives from the MOD Animal Defence Centre in Melton who will be demonstrating the skills of one of their canine colleagues before inviting your pooches to take a turn on their dog agility equipment!!

The Pet Show will commence at 2pm, categories include small caged animal, feline friend, and for dogs, best puppy, best old timer, waggiest tail and most like owner. Get your pet show application form from Penny at the Post Office, or enrol on the day before 1.30pm. The Green will be alive with game and craft stalls as well as a bouncy slide & bouncy castle, and the much acclaimed produce stall will be located under the horse chestnut tree, whilst the blacksmiths will be home to the Bar & BBO area.

In St Michael and All Angels Church you will have the opportunity to try your hand at bell ringing between 12 noon & 2pm, and it is here that you will also find a display of photographs of a bygone Hose, and a model railway for young and old to admire.

Strawberries and Fizz will be served between 2 pm & 3pm and you can enjoy these whilst being entertained by with music from local performers.

The school grounds will also be a hive of activity. The school have organised a children's art competition. There will be four categories, preschool, 4 to 7, 8 to 11 and 11 to 14 with fabulous prizes to be won. Barn Owl Project will be bringing one of their protégées, a beautiful baby owl, make sure you visit her in the school grounds. Other attractions will include tin can alley and the children's tombola and our roaming Street Entertainer will settle in the playground between 1.30 and 2pm to run a Circus Skills Workshop. Tsunamis originate when huge areas of
