CHANGES TO STREET LIGHTING

Leicestershire County Council is proposing changes to street lighting as part of its goal to make Leicestershire greener. They are considering 3 new options:

- Part-time lighting in residential areas
- Dimming of the brightest lights at non-peak hours
- Switching off lights in rural areas

By making these changes, the council estimates that about 3000 tonnes of carbon will be saved each year, saving about £700,000. Light pollution will be cut, so that we will be able to see the stars.

Agreed alterations will be shown on the **website** <u>www.leics.gov.uk/lighting</u> The alterations will start from April 2010 and will be carried out over a 4 year period. Currently there are no plans shown for the Melton district.
