

HOSE & DISTRICT GARDENING CLUB


Meetings are held at **Hose Village Hall at 7.30 pm on the first Thursday of the month.** Entry is free to members and £1 for visitors.

Hose now has its own village Public Access Defibrillator, situated on the shop wall in the centre of the village. This is to help in case someone has a heart attack and can be used by anyone, with or without training.

The defibrillator has been provided by the Community Heartbeat Trust - a national charity based in Leicestershire (www.communityheartbeat.org.uk), with support from Leicestershire County Council.

To get access you must first dial 999 Ambulance and follow their instructions.
